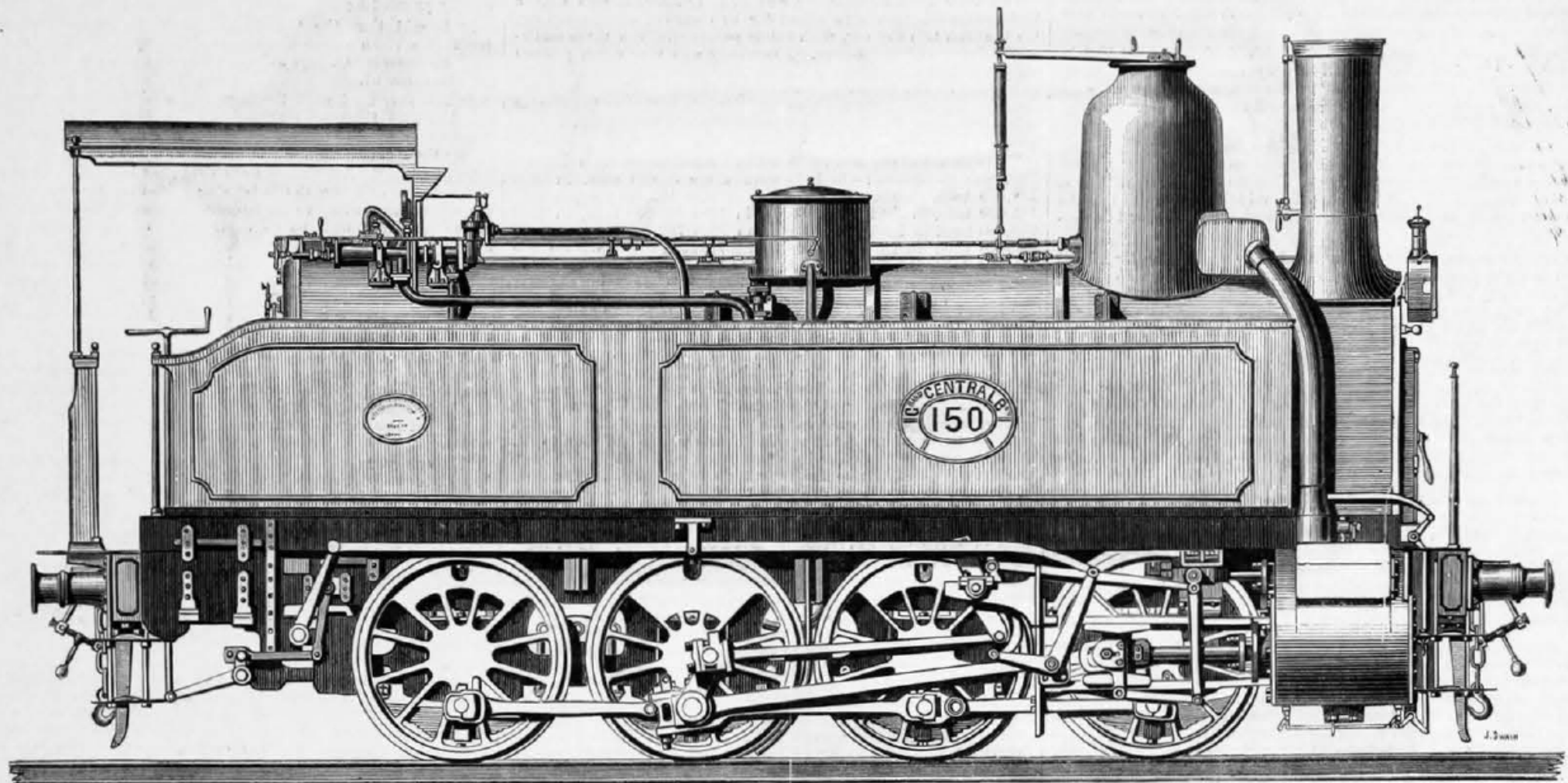

GOODS LOCOMOTIVE, GREAT CENTRAL RAILWAY OF BELGIUM.

CONSTRUCTED BY THE SOCIÉTÉ DE ST. LEONARD, LIEGE.



WE have in former impressions illustrated several locomotives constructed by the Société de St. Leonard for various lines, from the drawings of Mr. H. J. Vaessen, whose radial system we par-

ticularly described a few weeks since. We extend the series by the annexed engraving, showing a good tank engine, with eight coupled wheels, four feet in diameter. The cylinders are

18.11 inches in diameter, and the pistons have a stroke of 23.622 inches. The engraving will, we think, give so clear an idea of the engine that further description is scarcely necessary.
